"Just keep swimming" – can you guess who says this?

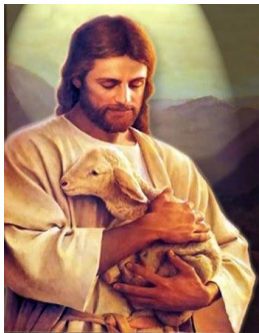
"To Infinity and Beyond!" – how about this one?
