They ran and hid among the trees. Did God find them? Sure he did. You can't hide from God

The Bible tells us that God chose David to be the king of Israel because he was "a man after God's own heart." (Acts 13:22) But even David did things that did not please God. There were probably times when David wished he could hide from God, but he knew it was impossible.

We can't hide from God either. He knows all about us. He knows what we are going to say before we say it and what we are going to do before we do it. It is foolish to play "Hide and Seek" with God. Besides, the reason God comes seeking is because he loves us and wants to bless us. Why would we want to hide from his blessing?

So I've written out the Psalm for today, I'd really like you to read it, or get help to read it and mark a couple of lines that as you read or as you heard it being read you thought I like that line or that sentence is really something I need to think about a bit more.
